
Leon, the Olympic silver medallist in the Synchronised Platform Diving Event in Athens, will be at the Pool on Saturday 26th March during the Scottish League.

This is the first year that Edinburgh Diving Club has sent a team to this event. The competition only necessitated an overnight stay, which we felt was a good starting point for new divers to the team. It was the last novice event for some of our more experienced divers, as they will be moving to Intermediate or Age Group competitions, and it seemed an appropriate "final outing" for them. It was also felt that the less experienced divers would gain experience and learn from the others.

The event was excellent with a friendly atmosphere. There were 8 different events within the competition. The top 6 competitors in each age group were presented with medals, the top three competitors received t-shirts and the winner received a trophy.

As well as winning the team trophy, Edinburgh divers won 4 events, with 11 medals in total. All the medal winners rose to the occasion and most achieved personal best scores. The less experienced divers all gained valuable experience and dived well

Special mention to the four winners:

<u>Laura Smith</u> dived beautifully to win the Girls 12/13 event, closely followed by her team mate Ellen Hood in silver medal position. Edinburgh had 3 divers on the podium in this event with a fourth diver narrowly missing out in 7th place. There were 21 divers in this event

Anna Sless excelled herself in the Girls 10/11 event, beating several JTP and TID divers. There were 26 competitors in this event.

Gillian Fleming won the Girls 14/18 event with a very good performance. Edinburgh again had three divers in the medals,

John Arthur won the Boys 14/18, diving well. It's good to see John back. Well done

The four chaperones were excellent and worked very well together. Thank you from all the divers and coaches. Having four chaperones made the trip run smoothly and consequently, the behaviour of the divers was excellent. As usual Davy was great with all the travel arrangements.

The only unfortunate part of the trip was that we had to catch the train home before the competition was finished, and did not realise that we had won. However.....

The Trophy will be presented to the team on Saturday, by Leon Taylor, which more than makes up for it!
